You will be advised by our staff of your preparation for your appointment. Most appointments require that you arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment time for registration, except for PET/CT scans. For PET/CT scans please arrive 30 minutes prior to your appointment time.

**General Patient Preparation**

If you are claustrophobic or have required sedation for previous scans, please advise us and bring a friend or relative who can drive you home

- Do not bring small children with you.
- Bring your Medicare/DVA card.
- Bring prior imaging.

**FDG PET/CT Patient Preparation**

- **If you are diabetic, you will need to call for specific instructions.**
- Fast for 6 hours prior to your scan, water is allowed.
- Avoid strenuous exercise for 24 hours prior to the scan.
- Wear warm clothing with no metal components.

**Ultrasound Patient Preparation**

- One and a half hours prior to appointment time, drink one litre of water, finishing 1 hour prior to appointment. Arrive with a full bladder.

**CT Patient Preparation**

- No solids for 2 hours prior to appointment **and** drink 1 litre of water starting 1 hour before appointment. You do not need to hold the water.
